Minutes for the April 2010, RCRC General Membership Meeting

Treasurer's report: The report was presented by the treasurer. A motion was made and seconded to accept the report as presented. The motion passed.

General Membership Minutes: A motion was made and seconded to approve the March 2010 General Membership Meeting minutes as published in the newsletter. The motion was voted on and passed.

April Board Meeting Minutes: A motion was made, seconded to approve the April Board Meeting minutes as published in the news letter. The motion was voted on and passed.

The President, Peter Wick announced that Mary Long had accepted the position of Publicity Chair Person. We all thank Mary for her acceptance of this position.

Peter also notified the membership that there have been several incidents where the gate has been left unlocked when no one was at the field including at least one case where it had been left open over night. Please any time you are last to leave the field; lock the gate

Old Business: No old business was discussed.

New business:

A formal proposal will be made to the city to repair the runway. Contractually they are supposed to do it but when requested orally they have said there was no funding available. This will put RCRC on record as officially requesting the repairs.

NCAC, the U control club, requested an area at the field to build a U Control circle. In order to do this their club members would become members of RCRC. The majority of members of the club seemed to feel this would be good for both club. The president stated that this would require a change in the contract with the city. Since the contract is written to limit activities to Radio Controlled Airplanes and no other activity is allowed. He also agreed to discuss the matter with Lou Hovatter, city representative.

A presentation was made to the members by Don Peck and Tim Batts, NARCA Representative. This presentation explained what club 40 racing was and requested that they be allowed to put on such an event at RCRC field.

A motion was made to allow such an event to be held at the field with Don Peck to be the CD and Tim Batts his assistant. After being seconded the motion was discussed, voted on and approved by the membership.

The date of the event was set for June 26, 2010, and an entry fee of \$10.00 with all proceeds to be retained by RCRC. A motion to accept the date and entry fee was made, seconded and a vote taken of the membership. The vote passed.

A motion that the meeting be adjourned was made at 8:00 PM. The motion was seconded voted on and passed by the membership.

About a month ago, Gary Courtney and I met high above the flying field. He was flying his YS powered ship, and I was flying my new electric airplane. My plane was a loss except for the electric pieces (motor, servos and radio), and Gary's plane was repairable. I had planned to build a new airplane fairly quickly. However, I was offered a part-time day job, which I accepted. For almost a month now, I have worked on the day job, ignoring the airplane. This is about to change; however, I haven't written anything on building this airplane. The following two pictures give you an idea of what the project is about.



Note that the first picture is the airplane stuff, and the second picture is the motor and its holder. I wired everything up, and the motor appears to run without any more vibration than it did when it was new. The servos are in one of the baggies in the first picture. 4 out of 5 had broken gear teeth. However, a new set of gears fixed them for about ¼ of the cost of new servos. I was so impressed with that result that I bought a gearset for the rudder servo for my Funtana. Unfortunately, not only was the gear broken, but the sockets in the plastic that retain the gears were broken. Next ime, I will take the servos apart before buying gears.
