I don't know if you read the recent article in the *Huntsville Times* outlining proposed changes to John Hunt Park. These changes include selling Joe Davis Stadium and other tracts of land in order to finance park improvements. December Membership Meeting minutes

The December 20, 2011 membership meeting was called to order by the president at 7:05 p.m. All the board members were present. There was not a quorum, or 20 percent of the membership, present.

There was no safety report but Vice President Basil Cooper asked those present to inform him if they witnessed any field rule violations. There then ensued a discussion with the floor concerning appropriate boundaries for flying safety.

Bob Walls has indicated that \$512 was donated to the "toys for tots" in the club's name.

Door prizes were handed out. President Jim Fowler showed a video of some of the military's full scale helicopters.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:45 p.m.
