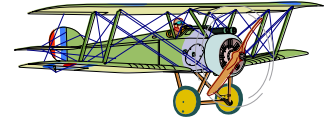

RCRC Club Meeting**

The meeting was called to order at 6:04pm. A quorum was present. Treasurer and Secretary were not present. President, Vice President, and Newsletter Editor were in attendance.

Soon-to-be new member Alex Adams introduced himself and was welcomed by the club. The following Old Business items passed unanimously.

- April Meeting Minutes and Newsletter content.
- May Treasurer's Report
- Safety Report (no safety issues)

Treasurer Report

- Income = \$740.75
- Expenses = \$580.65
- Money Market = \$7690.86
- Checking = \$3571.92

New Business

Final voting took place on two bylaw amendments. Both passed by at least a 2/3 majority.

- Quorum Reduction to Ten (10) members or Ten (10) percent.
Passed: 39 yay 7 nay
- Bylaw Amendment Process Change.
Passed: 41 yay 5 nay

The bylaws will be updated with approved amendments and signed by the President and Secretary. The updated bylaws will then be published on the RCRC website and appropriate paper copies placed in the clubhouse and flight shed.

Presentation of Club Day agenda and schedule was delivered by the VP.

Meeting was adjourned at 6:20pm.
