A donation will be made to the club. A motion to grant the discussed exclusive use was made, seconded, and passed by quorum vote.
- Club member Taylor Abington of Avion Solutions gave an extremely informative presentation on airspace classification and how it applies to RCRC operations.
- FAA regulations and how they apply to recreational RC pilots (RCRC members) were discussed.
 - 400 foot above ground level altitude restriction.
 - o Fly only within visual line of site. Beyond visual line of site flight are not permitted.
 - There is no speed limit that applies to recreational RC aircraft.
 - o Pilots must register with the FAA and place their registration number on the outside of any aircraft that they operate. Passing of an online test will also be required eventually.
 - Pilots are responsible for their own actions/inactions related to FAA. RCRC will not police or enforce FAA regulations at this time.
 - The AMA and RCRC Inc. are not entities that are recognized by the FAA.
