- City Road Repair Status. Groups of streets are pulled together in a batch and contracted as a package. This street will be included in one of those batches. I don't have a timeline for this specific street yet."
- City-RCRC Agreement Renewal. Dr. Jeanie Robinson and John Hamilton have both been contacted about beginning the renewal process. They were also provided with a copy of our current contract. The contract expires December 31, 2020. The contract renewal tasks have been given to the city's legal department. This is currently slated for a late spring-early summer action.
- FAA Status: No changes since last discussion at October club meeting.
- Club reminder of Avion Private event tomorrow (20-November).
- 2020 Board of Directors Election. Three online votes, six paper ballots. No write-ins. As a result, all RCRC Board of Directors are hereby re-elected for the 2020 term.

New Business:

- EarthScope and Huntsville City Schools will be making periodic drive-by teaching sessions about the landfill from the club's parking lot. These visits typically last five minutes or less and all teaching occurs on the bus. Nobody will be exiting the bus during these brief visits. A schedule is included below.
- Discussion of gravel being used as a temporary road fix was made. Clint Bestor and Al Blair were instructed to proceed with this effort in December.
