The members in attendance overwhelmingly wanted pets to be allowed at RCRC. The board was tasked with authoring an addition to field regulations that will govern the presence of pets at the field. This addendum will be edited/updated based on member feedback at the July meeting and voted on once finalized at the same meeting. Draft addendum is on page four of this newsletter.
- The city was out measuring the parking lot and approach road in preparation of resurfacing. At this time, we have no other information other than it -should- be executed calendar year 2020.

Field Regulations Proposed Addendums for Pets:

Proposal 1: Pets are not permitted at the RCRC field.

Proposal 2: Pets are permitted at the RCRC field under the following conditions.

- Pets must be kept on a leash at all times.
- Pets must be kept under control by its owner at all times.
- Pets must be kept away from all equipment, aircraft, or persons that do not wish contact with the pet.
- All Huntsville City pet ordinances must be adhered-to at all times.

- The pet owner is solely responsible for any issues that may arise as a result of their pet's behavior. This
 responsibility includes any potential financial liability. Examples include, but are not limited to, cost of
 re-imbursement for equipment or aircraft damaged by the pet's behavior and medical
 bills/compensation for an injury resulting from the pet's behavior.
- Violations to this policy or any pet incidents should be reported to the RCRC board of directors immediately.
- Disciplinary action permitted by club bylaws and field regulations may be taken against the pet owner and restrictions may be placed on the pet's activity in response to a violation, incident, or complaint. The RCRC board of directors will have sole authority to enact and enforce any actions that might be taken against the pet owner and the specific pet in direct response to a violation or incident.
- RCRC will not be involved in any legal discussions or legal determinations of liability or worth. It is the
 responsibility of those directly involved in an incident to negotiate a satisfactory resolution of the
 incident.
