March 2013 General Membership Meeting Minutes

The meeting was called to order at 7:04 PM by the President. All Board members were present.

A quorum was not present.

The minutes of the February membership meeting were approved as printed in the Newsletter.

The Treasurer's report was read and approved.

The President reported that the recent Inventory was one gallon short and \$13 over in the cash box.

The president reported that Eric Enchelmayer, the City contact, was given a gate combination for use by the City's grass mowing crew. The gate was repaired today but the fence and runway repairs which we requested remain to be done.

The President reported that Bob Sorrells has accepted appointment to fill the vacant Webmaster position and continues to work on development of the on-line renewal capability.

The USPS has rejected our request for bulk mail rate because, among other things, social and hobby clubs such as ours are not eligible.

The VP, at AMA request to all clubs, briefed the Membership regarding the recent incident involving a quadracopter into airspace in the NY City area and reported on the national news and the potential adverse impact on our hobby. A number of States are preparing legislation regarding use of drones which pose a threat to our hobby. All members are asked to stay in touch with developments on this subject.

Bill Mitchell continues as temporary Field Chairman and a volunteer is needed to fill the position. There were no reports from Publicity and Safety.

The President reported that AMA Competitions had emailed requesting support for the USA RC Aerobatics Team going to South Africa to compete in the 2013 World Championships. One of our member's son is the Junior Member on the team and Jon Lowe is the President of the NSRCA. With this announcement, a motion was made and seconded for a \$100 contribution.

April 2013 RCRC BOD Meeting Minutes

New windsocks have been ordered and should be here soon. Some discussion was had regarding the method of securing them to the posts in the field and on top of the shed.

The request for donations to the USA RC Helicopter team was discussed. The Board agreed that the club will not donate but individual members can make a donation if they wish.

The President and Vice President are working on a draft version of the flying field regulations. A committee will be formed to evaluate the draft version before it is brought before the membership for voting.

The Vice President will CD the Big Bird fly-in on June 8 and the War Bird fly-in on July 27. Both events will be non-sanctioned and will be for club members only. The field will be open to all members who want to fly on the days of the events. During the War Bird event we will be accepting donations for the Wounded Warrior Foundation.

The Board discussed the current condition of the runway and the President will email Eric Enchelmayer what it would take to get the runway reestablished/resurfaced and can the city do it.
