June 18, 2013 General Membership Meeting Minutes The meeting was called to order at 7:03 PM by the President. All Board members were present.

A quorum was not present.

Two new members introduced themselves—Matt McCarty and Tom Wimsatt. We welcome them and look forward to seeing them at the flying field.

The May and June newsletters were approved.

The Treasurer's report was made and approved as read. The President reported a\on a couple of items as follows: A number of RC airplanes and related parts were donated by a stranger Mark Arski at the recent Big Bird event. These will be inventoried and made available for bids by the membership. The IRS responded with notice of acceptance of our application and fee payment. He has been unsuccessful in reaching the CAP regarding further interest on their part for a joint educational program for the Cadets. He will continue to make contact and feels that we can accommodate a half dozen students providing sufficient interest is shown.

The VP reported good results at the Big Bird event, which was attended by our District VP, Jose Soto, who made several suggestions for future events with his support. These include a City appreciation Day which could be potentially a part of next year's Club Day event and his support for a District Flyin which He would plan and fund, with Club support. (Soto also announced that he will not run for reelection as District VP but will run for election as AMA President, encouraging Rick Grimm to run as his replacement.)The President added a comment noting that Soto took the opportunity at the lunchtime gathering to present Basil Cooper a nice plague on behalf of the AMA in recognition of Basil's generous donation to the AMA scholarship fund which was announced several months ago on the AMA website.

A suggestion was made to change the website wording to invite non-RCRC AMA members to join us for the War Bird event in July. The Web Editor will be asked to do this.

David Seymour received an e-mail from an individual in Hollywood, Al offering to sell a lot of RC planes. This will

be forwarded to the membership by e-mail for action by those interested.

NEW BUSINESS

The President noted that the CD corrected the date for the BPA Pattern event to Aug 9-11 as shown in the Newsletter. This change was approved.
