The AMA initially advised its membership to hold-off Secretary registering the FAA. Today (11-Jan-2016), the AMA has released Alan Berard 256-337-5785 a statement realizing it is unlikely that any solution coming from Treasurer its negotiations with the FAA will be finalized by the registration John Tubb 401-450-9669 Newsletter Editor deadline of 19-Feb-2016. As a result, the AMA is now Tom Wimsatt 401-222-0658 recommending registration for those that do not wish to violate the **Committee Chairmen** federal rule. FAA registration will still be free (via refund) until Field Tuesday 19-Jan-2016.

After extensive discussion amongst the membership body present at the December 2015 meeting, it was decided that RCRC will NOT impose any new rules or regulations whatsoever related to FAA registration until directed to do so by the AMA or the City of Huntsville.

The online registration is a relatively quick and painless task, and a paper method is also available. I would like to remind everyone that while the FAA is now mandating UAS registration, NO NEW RULES OR REGULATIONS ARE BEING IMPOSED on us or our aircraft.

Please don't let something like this rob or ruin your enjoyment and love of being an RC pilot and builder. While it will take some time for the organizations involved to work out the path ahead, I do not believe that FAA registration is the death knell of this great hobby! Wherever you fall on the issue of registration, please continue to enjoy yourself and carry-on business as usual.

Section 4: The presence of not less than twenty percent (20%) of the voting members or twenty (20) voting members (whichever is less) two of which must be officers, shall constitute a quorum.

Section 4: The presence of not less than ten percent (10%) of the voting members or ten (10) voting members (whichever is less) two of which must be officers, shall constitute a quorum.
