FAA registration is back. Congress and the President have reinstated the requirement for FAA UAS registration for any aircraft over 8oz. in weight. As before, this is a private matter between pilots/operators and the FAA. The AMA and RCRC will NOT be policing or enforcing FAA UAS registration.

I have had several people come to me asking about turbine aircraft. Use of turbine aircraft is allowed at RCRC. There is an additional requirement by AMA that you must possess an AMA Turbine Waiver to allow you to operate a turbine at any AMA-sanctioned field.

Proposed field regulation changes to allow use of Hi-Start/Winches as discussed during the Nov 2017 meeting.

Original:

8) Flight Operations

d) Pilots of powered Gliders shall launch their aircraft from the flight boxes. Gliders may utilize the grass area east of the runway for landing. Winches or Hi-Starts shall not be used since they are a safety hazard to other aircraft.

Proposed:

8) Flight Operations

- d) Gliders pilots shall utilize flight boxes for the duration of flight. Winches and Hi-Starts may be used with the following provisions:
 - They shall not interfere with, and give right-of-way to, all other flight operations.
 - Launch equipment shall utilize the area to the east of the runway.
 - Use must be coordinated with all other pilots operating aircraft.
